

Stephanie Velicity Strickland Chavis was born in Robeson County, on April 5, 1965, to the late Ray Strickland and wife Pandora, of Pembroke. Her mother was an Educator and her father was a Law Enforcement official. She has one sibling; Michelle Strickland. Stephanie was married to the late Delwood Chavis, and they had two daughters, Anya ShaLee and Kristen Mataya. She is blessed with three grands; Xavier, Aloysius and Adelyn.

Stephanie was one of the members of the last graduating class of Prospect High School, Class of 1983, just before students had to begin attending Purnell Swett High School. After graduating from High School, Stephanie continued her education at Pembroke State University, now known as UNC-Pembroke. She graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice. Since the University was established in 1887, the school celebrated its centennial in 1987. With Stephanie graduating in the Pembroke State University Class of 1987, she became a part of history, along with the other graduates, who signed a document which was placed in the wall of the Student Center, to be opened in the year 2087.

Stephanie began working for Robeson County Emergency Management as secretary in 1988 and later moved over to the Fire Marshal's office in 1992 to fill the position as Fire Inspector and Fire Investigator. Stephanie continued to work as Fire Inspector and Fire Investigator until November of 2013

when she was promoted to Director of Emergency Management and County Fire Marshal.

Stephanie is one (1) of six (6) female **Emergency Management Directors and** one (1) of three (3) female Fire Marshal in the state of North Carolina. She is the only female Lumbee Indian to hold these positions in North Carolina. She is responsible for planning and leading the responses to natural disasters and other emergencies. With Hurricane Matthew in 2016 and Hurricane Florence in 2018, Robeson County was exposed to devastation not seen in 50 + years. Stephanie served as the lead first responder in both incidents. She has served her county for more than 30 years and has a deep love for God, family, her job, the citizens and especially first responders.

Color Me Healthy Robeson is a program delivered in child care centers, home child care programs, and Head Start classrooms. This curriculum is used with 4- and 5-year olds and is designed to show children that healthy food and physical activity are fun. This is accomplished through the use of color, music, dance, and imaginary play to provide opportunities for physical activity and to teach children about healthy eating.

The Dolly Parton Imagination Library helps young children develop pre-literacy skills by mailing free books once a month. All preschool children (birth through five) that live in Robeson County are eligible. Childcare facilities are made aware of the components of quality care to enhance their facility using the Environment Rating Scales. Assessments of licensed facilities allow for quality enhancement materials. Technical assistance and maintenance is also provided.

This activity provides an on-site resource center to all child care providers and caretakers of children ages birth through five years old.

#### NC PRE-K TRANSPORTATION

Agency: Robeson County Partnership for Children

Financial assistance is provided to child care facilities to transport eligible NC Pre-K children to and from approved NC Pre-K sites. This activity ensures that children are able to attend a high quality learning environment to promote their overall development.

#### NURSE FAMILY PARTNERSHIP

Registered nurses visit eligible women in their homes during their first pregnancy and throughout the first two years of their children's lives. The program is a statewide initiative following a national model that seeks to improve pregnancy outcomes and child health through primary prevention. Additionally, the program seeks to improve the economic self-sufficiency of the family through personal development goals.



Professional Development provides services for licensed child care facilities in Robeson County.



Services include technical assistance in the form of intensive one-on-one coaching provided to selected early childhood educators working in infant, toddler and pre-k classrooms. The activity is implemented using My Teaching Partner Coaching (MTP) and focuses on improving teacher-child interactions as measured by the CLASS tool. MTP, monetary awards are offered to eligible participants. Academic advising is offered to students enrolled in Early Childhood courses as requested

#### READY, SET. GO

Agency: Riverbend Services, Inc. (910) 618-9260

Training and consultation is offered to child care providers on applying promotion, prevention, and intervention when working with children who experience developmental and/or behavioral health symptoms. The Pyramid Model and Cognitive Behavioral techniques are used to incorporate positive, problem-focused, and goal-directed interventions. Child care staff are trained on using specific techniques that promote a healthy environment for children to grow emotionally and developmentally.

#### **SEEDS FOR SUCCESS**

Agency: Robeson County Partnership for Children

Seeds 4 Success facilitates Kaleidoscope Play and Learn Groups for children birth through five and their caregivers not enrolled in full-time regulated childcare. Weekly play groups are held using culturally- and developmentally- appropriate play activities for children and caregivers to participate in together. Facilitators guide and model conversation, peer-to-peer learning and hands-on experience that provide parents with tools to use at home to support children's learning and healthy development.

# FREE High Quality PRE-K

### Now enrolling for the 2021-2022 School Year

Your child may be eligible to attend Robeson County's NC Pre-K Program. The NC Pre-K Program is designed to provide high-quality educational experiences to enhance school readiness for eligible four year old children.

Children must be four years old by August 31, 2021 to be eligible for the program. Parents must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate, current immunization records, income verification, and proof of chronic health conditions, if applicable. All items are required to determine eligibility.

# Teen Wiss Lumbee Kyla Leigh-Ann Jarrett



Kyla grew up in the Raleigh area but Robeson county has always been her second home. She has a passion and love for serving her Lumbee people.



- · Demonstrates a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability; and
- Has a household income at or below 80 percent of the area median.

Rental assistance provided to an eligible household should not be duplicative of any other federally funded rental assistance provided to such household

Rent, Rent arrears, utilities. For the purpose of RPRP "utilities" includes: electricity, gas, water, sewer, trash removal, internet, and energy, such as fuel oil. Utilities does not include telecommunication services, such as telephone and cable.


