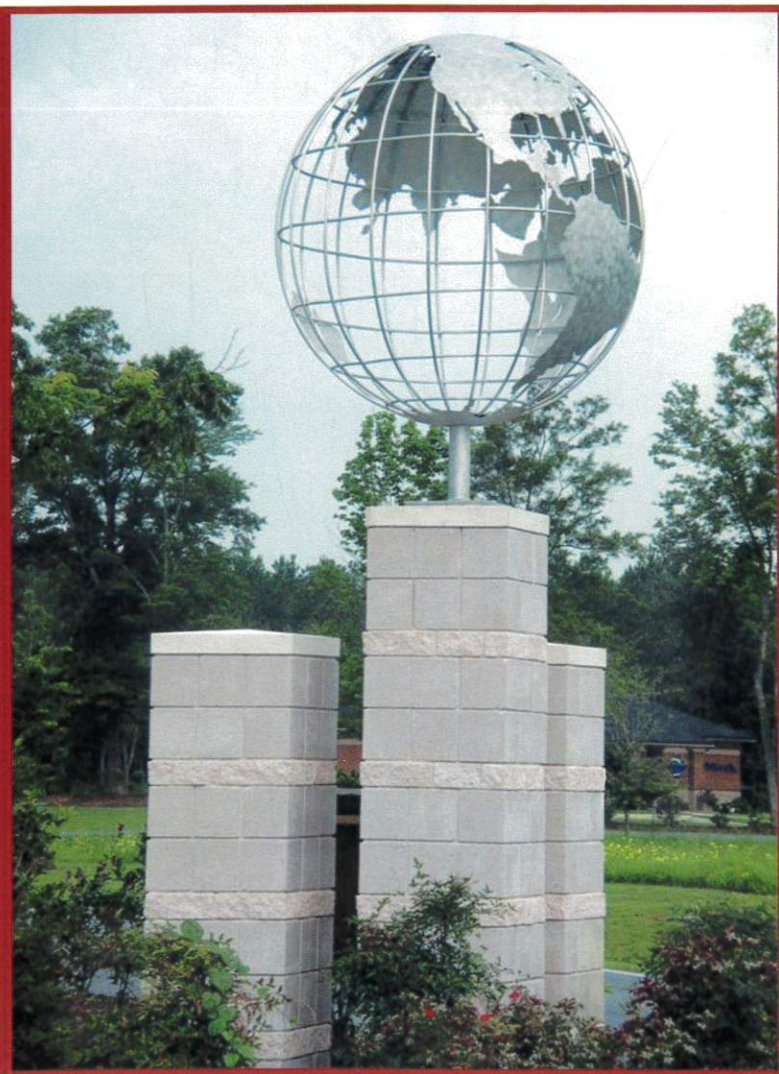

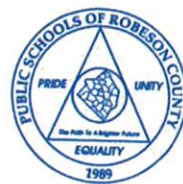

Memorial to Mr. Odell Lowry



SHANNON – The American Indian community is still mourning the untimely death of LRDA board member, church, civic and community leader, and volunteer Odell Lowry.

Lowry's wife and family received some comfort knowing he died doing something he loved. For the past 12 years, the Shannon resident had grown attached to the senior citizens at his church, Freedom Assembly of God in Red Springs. He often took them on trips out of town.

On Dec. 5, Lowry took 60 seniors out to lunch in Pembroke, to the flea markets in Cherry Grove and then to the Dixie Stampede show in Myrtle Beach, S.C. After the show Lowry helped many of them out of the amphitheater. He collapsed in the elevator, as they were getting ready to leave. His family said he had a heart attack. He was 60.

Lowry served on the LRDA board for 12 years, representing the Shannon and Red Springs area. Every year during Lumbee Homecoming, Lowry organized the Gospel Sing. This past summer he raised funds to bring well-known gospel singer, Quinton Mills, to the Gospel Sing.

"We've lost a great board member," James Hardin, LRDA Executive Director said. "He was not only a part of setting policy and guiding the organization, but he volunteered his time with Lumbee Homecoming and other projects. He took the gospel sing and ran with it. That helped us out a lot. He will be missed on the board and as a volunteer in the community. He was highly respected and well thought of."

Lowry was born Jan. 6, 1948, the son of Garfield Jacobs and Zelma Lowry. He was raised in the Fairmont area. He graduated from Prospect School and joined the Army in 1969. He fought in Vietnam from 1970 to 1971 and earned the rank of Sergeant. He returned home and joined the National Guard while working in the construction business. Around this time, Lowry began volunteering his time in the community. He served as president of the Jaycees in Shannon, joined the Shannon Volunteer Fire Department and the VFW in Pembroke.

He was working with Daniel's Construction in South Carolina when he met his wife, Darcos Brayboy. When Odell and Darcos married they did not go on a honeymoon. They both had family members who came in from out of town and they wanted to spend time with them. Over the years they talked about taking a trip alone but it never seemed to fall in place until 2008.

"We used to take trips with other couples," Darcos said. "I wanted this to be our time."

On their 32nd anniversary — Sept. 24 — the couple flew to New York. They rented a car and toured Ground Zero before driving to Canada. Their destination was Niagara Falls.

"We stayed in the Embassy Suites right on Niagara Falls," she said. "There was one great big window in the room. Every night they would shoot off fireworks. We acted like kids that whole week. We done the tour, saw the sites, the exhibits and done everything we wanted to do. That was God's way of giving me that time with him before it was his time to go."

"I am so privileged and honored that God chose me to have him as a husband," Darcos went on to say. "He was a fine descent person who had a wonderful character. He loved the Lord and loved serving the Lord."

Community Activist

Lowry continued his community involvement after settling in Shannon. At one time, he served on seven boards at the same time, including the Robeson County Daycare Board.

He served on the advisory board at Freedom Assembly of God and the Native American Bible College board.

He would help senior citizens who were on fixed incomes or people who had sickness in their family. He helped organized the Christmas baskets every year for the tribal elders. Last year they delivered more than 500 baskets. He helped several people get new houses or their houses worked on through LRDA.

He was a man that loved doing for people. All those who knew him will miss him. This Memorial Page is in his honor.

LARRY R. CHAVIS

Larry Chavis is a 1972 graduate of Pembroke State University with a B.S. in Accounting. He received his MBA from Campbell University. He is also a graduate of the Mid-Management Banking at UNC-Chapel Hill and the Bank Controllership Graduate Program through the University of Wisconsin. Mr. Chavis' parents are Agnes Chavis and the late George Chavis. He is married to Loleta Hunt and they have two children, Melissa and Alex. He was reared by his grandparents, Gus and Flowers Hunt.

He served two years in the U.S. Army as a POW Interrogator in Vietnam from 1968-1969. He was employed with Southern National Bank from 1972 until 1987, having ascended to the position of Vice President in the Accounting Department. Mr.

Chavis began his career with Lumbee Guaranty Bank in July 1987 as President and CEO. Since that time, Lumbee Guaranty Bank has expanded from one location to now having twelve locations. Under his leadership, Lumbee Guaranty Bank presently has 100 employees. As of Dec. 31, 2008 total assets were \$236,692,621 and deposits were \$180,532,335.

Mr. Chavis is an active member of many organizations related to banking and finance. He currently serves on a board of the North Carolina Banking Commission and is Chairperson of his North Carolina Bankers Peer Group. Mr. Chavis has served as a Director of the North Carolina Bankers Association and the Community Bankers Association.

Mr. Chavis is also very active in many organizations such as the Boy Scouts of America, Kiwanis, UNCP-Foundation & Endowment Board, Thomas Family Center for Entrepreneurship Advisory Board, UNCP Business Department Advisory Board, Southeastern Utilities Development Board, Southeastern Regional Medical Center Foundation Board, Duke Heart Center, North Carolina Indian Economic Development Initiative, North Carolina Economic Development Initiative, the VFW, South Robeson High School Booster Club, Treasurer and Deacon of Reedy Branch Baptist Church. He has served in various leadership roles, including president, of many of these organizations. Mr. Chavis was awarded "BUSINESS MAN OF THE YEAR" in 1992 by the Lumbee Regional Development Association. He also received the 1999 Silver Beaver Award from Boy Scouts, Governors Award, Distinguished Service to Agriculture, Kiwanian of the year, UNC Pembroke Distinguished Alumni, Economic Advancement of Indian People Award (United Tribes of NC) and many more accolades.

Mr. Chavis loves all types of sports and enjoys traveling.

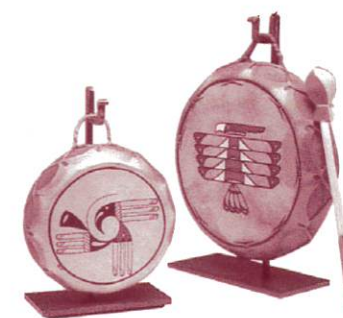

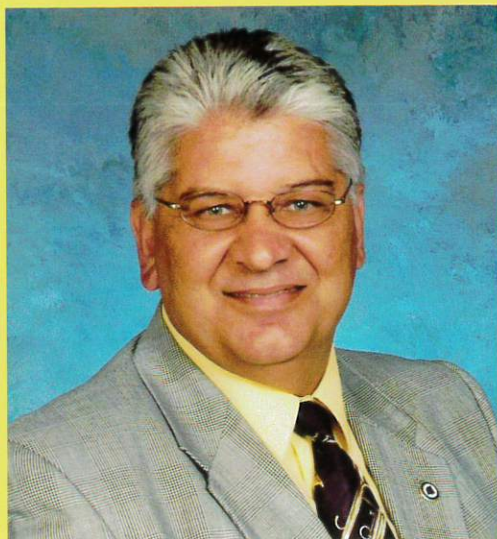

CHAMPION FOR CHILDREN

Tribute to Mrs. Patricia B. Locklear

Thanks a million! The words often spoken by Mrs. Patricia B. Locklear, the former Head Start Director at LRDA, to her staff members, peers and co-workers who devoted endless hours and sacrifices for the children of Robeson County and across the state of North Carolina.

Mrs. Locklear started her career as a Head Start Social Service Aid in 1967 and over the course of 17 years, through hard work and determination; she went through the ranks and became the Head Start Director at Lumbee Regional Development Association (LRDA) in 1984. During her 28 year tenure as Head Start Director, the program was funded with \$200,000 per year and at her retirement the program was supported by over \$1 million. The program also went from being a day to a full day program at 3 sites, serving thousands of children in Rennert, Fairgrove, Allenton, Shannon, and Smyrna communities. Staff members increased from 12 to over 50 employees supported by the Head Start/Early Head Programs, most of which had a 2 year or 4 year degree.

Mrs. Patricia has always been known as a visionary and one of her greatest visions became reality for her in 2003, when she wrote a grant that enabled LRDA to receive funds to start the first Early Childhood program in Robeson County. The grant provided \$100,000 for start up planning and an additional \$433,259 to complete the construction of a 13,000 square foot facility in the Greengrove community of Fairmont. The project consolidated the Early Childhood and Head Start programs at Fairgrove and provided new services to 32 children and 8 pregnant women, infants and toddlers and employed 10 additional staff. Overall, this project represented a \$1 million dollar investment by LRDA in this community. A few other accomplishments for Mrs. Locklear are the following:

- Received Champion for Children award for Robeson County from Governor Hunt in 2000.
- Graduated from UNC-Pembroke with a Bachelors in American Indian Studies, 2003
- Robeson County Partnership for Children (Smart Start), served 10 years as a Board of Director
- Native American Women's Investment Club, 1998
- N.C. Head Start Association, Chairperson Membership Committee
- Ms. Lumbee Pageant, Chairperson 1989-1993
- Guardian Ad Litem (Volunteer), 1987-2001
- "Voices for Children" Committee Member, 1983-1984
- Wrote "Learning Together", Published at Western Kentucky University in 1985

James Hardin, current executive director of LRDA stated that, "Patricia Locklear's contribution to this organization has been tremendous and will be long enduring. The child services area grew tremendously over the years because of her steadfast labors to service her first love, children."

Mrs. Patricia was also known for encouraging all staff to pursue higher education and she mentored several co-workers. She believed that by the teachers learning then the children were learning also, and therefore they will receive a better education. Rev. Jeanette B. Locklear, a former co-worker who worked with Mrs. Patricia for 3 years as the Family Community Partnership Manager was inspired by her and has since gone on to complete a Masters degree in Library Science. Mrs. Jeanette states that "Mrs. Patricia is a woman of distinction and deserves to be recognized for her contributions in early childhood education because of the children she has helped and the lives she has touched."

She was determined by her own self motivation and encouragement from Dr. Linda Oxendine by obtaining her Bachelors Degree in American Indian Studies from University of North Carolina at Pembroke in 2003. All this would not have been possible had it not been for the support of her loving husband Rudy Locklear of the Union Chapel Community. They have 3 children, Roderick Brewer, Kandice Locklear, Kristy Locklear, and one grandson, Drew Bradley Allen.

Mrs. Patricia has always believed in children receiving high-quality childcare and education, regardless of race, ethnicity or socioeconomic status. During an interview with Vinita Clark, Carolina Indian Voice, in 2004, Mrs. Patricia is quoted as saying "A child is a child and if I am to be remembered by someone, it will be as an advocate for the children. Someone who took the time to care." And we leave you with these famous words, often spoken by Mrs. Patricia and that is "how are the children?"



CHAMPION FOR SENIORS

Tribute to Miss Shirley Locklear

Shirley Locklear is a retired administrator with extensive experience and success in providing services to low-income Indian families in Robeson and adjoining counties. From 1974 to 2003, she was a key leader in major programs of Lumbee Regional Development Association that served disadvantaged people. During her career, Ms. Locklear served as the Director of the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program, REACH, Community Food and Nutrition Program, SSI Outreach, and other programs that helped Indian families to obtain services including home energy assistance, food stamps, Medicaid, and AFDC.

Of her work Ms. Locklear stated, "I always felt my job was to fight for my people and open doors to see that needy families received help." Her contributions and leadership resulted in new and improved services to Indian people, which are still being felt today. Ms. Locklear managed the first major block grant of funds from the federal government to the Lumbee Tribe in partnership with the State of North Carolina. This program was a model that other tribes and state agencies

followed. The Lumbee Energy Assistance Program is now operated by the Lumbee Tribe of North Carolina and has an annual budget of over \$2 million.

Ms. Locklear organized partnerships with a host of agencies at the local, state, and national levels, such as the Lutheran and Presbyterian churches. She helped LRDA organize and operate an annual food distribution program at Christmas that served thousands of people. Ms. Locklear was a leader in organizing services for Indian elders, in providing free and low cost food for needy families, and improving education and health services in the region. She continues to serve as a volunteer leader with local elders and the Senior Traveling Companions.

Other notes on Ms. Shirley Locklear:

- Mother of two children, four grandchildren.
- Employment with LRDA: June 1, 1974 to Sept. 30, 2003
- 1974-76 Emergency Food and Medical Services
- Received training at UNC-Chapel Hill on health care outreach, to refer clients to other services
- 1977- 2003 served as Project Director and Program Manager for various LRDA programs
- 1976-86 Director of Community Food and Nutrition Program
- Helped clients to apply for food stamps and other needs, organized a food pantry and low-cost alternative food coop for low-income families
- 1976-86 Received extra grants from Lutheran and Presbyterian churches. Organized and lead efforts to establish an annual LRDA food distribution program for Christmas.
- 1986 to 2003 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program
- 1991 to 1993 Director of Lumbee SSI Outreach Project, which completes outreach, services to enroll eligible Indian families into the SSI program of Social Security Admin.
- In her early years as a staff leader with the Emergency Food and Medical Services program, she helped many Indian families to obtain services including food stamps, Medicaid, and AFDC.
- During her 30 year career, Ms. Locklear helped prepare grant applications and administer programs for a total of over 25 millions in grant dollars to provide services to Indian communities.

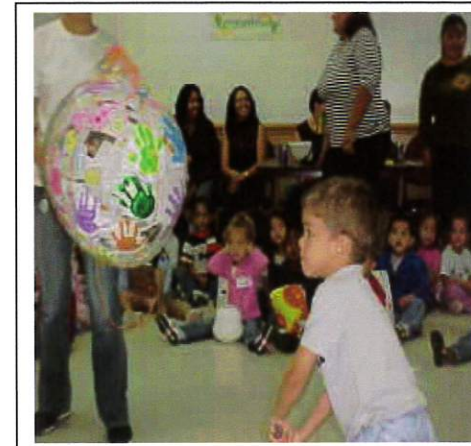

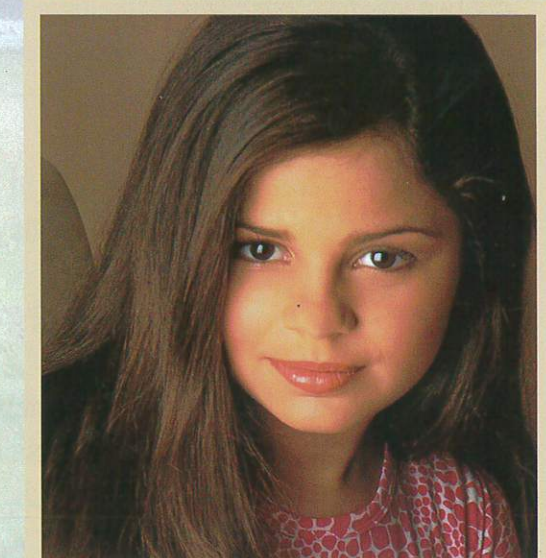

LRDA manages and owns 59 Lease Purchase Homes in Robeson and Hoke Counties.

These are scattered site homes which will be transferred to the housing client once they meet the conditions of their Memorandum of Agreements (MOA) and housing policy terms.

All 59 homes are stick built or modular on permanent foundations.

All homes were built with federal funds between 2000 and 2002 under the HUD program, called the Native American Housing and Self-Determination Act.

Cypress Gardens

LRDA owns a housing development called Cypress Gardens, which has 16 lots, located off Highway 711 out of Pembroke.

Two lots are developed at this time, and the LRDA board will decide once the economy improves when to move forward with further development of this property for home ownership.

A nine-acre tract is also owned off of West 5th Street in Lumberton, N.C. That tract is currently listed for sale by the agency.


Management of Properties

Beginning June 1, 2009 management of these properties was contracted to Lumbee Enterprise Development, Inc, a subsidiary of Lumbee Revitalization and Community Development Corporation.

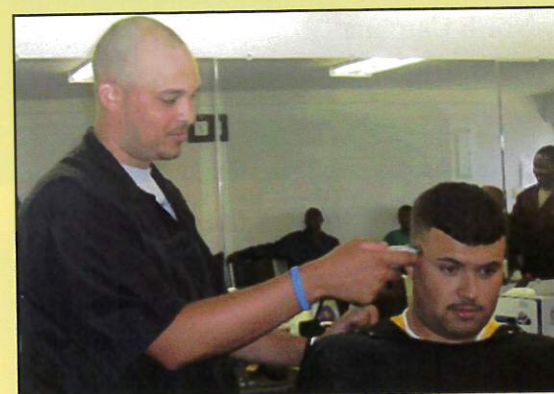


On the Job Training
