BARTO CLARK JR.

MR. BARTO CLARK JR. has been serving in the Lumbee community for more than fifty years. He is an enrolled member of the Lumbee tribe from the Pembroke community. He grew up in the town of Pembroke in a family that believed in hard work and education.

Mr. Barto enjoys spending time with his family. He and his wife, Geraldine Jacobs Clark, have four adult children who are occupied with their respective careers and families. Marco and his wife Rose live in Maxton. They have three daughters; Amy Tennille Lowry, Courtney and Cristina Clark.. Tina lives in Pembroke with her two children; Adrianna Hunt and Hal Hunt Jr. Kyle and his wife Donna live in the Deep Branch community. They have two children; Kaleb and Kaci Clark. Tona and her husband Allen, live in Hoke County. They have three children; Chrystal Jacobs McGirt, Thomas-Allen and Taylor Jacobs. All of the children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren are proud of the heritage and enjoy gathering in their famous spot for the annual Lumbee Homecoming parade.

Since his retirement in 1985, Mr. Clark has enjoyed his vegetable garden; giving away more vegetables than he kept for himself and working in his yard. He enjoyed cooking for his growing family during the traditional Monday night suppers. Those Monday suppers have now become Sunday evening gatherings

with children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. He is very active in his church.

Berea Baptist in Pembroke where he served as a deacon, trustee and Sunday School teacher. His goal as a Sunday School teacher was to entice others to become Sunday School teachers. He was able to see his dream come to fruition. Under his guidance and Godly leadership, his Sunday School class has produced several excellent teachers for Berea Baptist Church. Mr. Barto, along with several other prominent Lumbee members, worked together to write the guidelines and by-laws for the incorporation of the Lumbee Tribe (Lumbee Regional Development Association).

Mr. Barto attended Pembroke Graded and Pembroke High School (currently the PSRC Indian Education Facility). Upon graduation from Pembroke High School, he attended welding school in Wilmington and worked in the shipyard. He also worked in the car industry in Michigan for a brief period. After serving in the US Navy as a shipman, Mr. Barto returned to Pembroke and enrolled in Pembroke Indian Normal School (Pembroke State College). Upon graduating with a Bachelor's Degree (Social Studies/History), from Pembroke College, he enrolled at Wayne State University, in Michigan, where he obtained a Master's in School Administration. After graduation, he returned to Robeson County and began teaching Social Studies/US History at Magnolia High School. Mr. Barto was honored as one of the first Native American graduates and as President of the Student Government at Pembroke College. A brick, engraved with his name, is located in front of the Old Main Building (UNC-Pembroke).

During his tenure at Magnolia, Mr. Barto met his wife, Geraldine Jacobs and they married in 1954. Soon after, he became principal at Union Chapel School for several years. In 1964, he moved his family to a new home in Pembroke, where he and Ms. Geraldine still reside. He became principal at Pembroke High School, currently the PSRC Indian Educational Resource Center. He moved to the new Pembroke High School, currently Pembroke Middle School and remained principal until 1975. He missed his first love, teaching, and returned to the classroom teaching Social Studies and US History until his retirement in 1985. All four of his children were blessed to have him as a principal and or as a teacher.

Mr. Barto has helped to pave the way for many young Lumbee people through his teachings and his patience. His humble demeanors, ability to remain calm in stressful situations, and his objectivity have helped to mold and shape minds. Former students and parents give Mr. Barto credit for their accomplishments in life. This is evidenced by the many visits, invitations to reunions, service on various community boards, and other activities. During a recent surprise 88th birthday party, hundreds of guests showed up to honor him and many spoke of the difference he made in their lives.

The Lumbee people and Pembroke community has been blessed Mr. Barto's presence and his service for the past 50 plus years. He has been the solid foundation for the community and continues to be a mentor for many.

RONNIE NEAL SUTTON

COMMANDER, U.S. NAVY (RETIRED)

REARED on a farm in the Saddletree Community, Commander Sutton is the son of the late Willie French Sutton and the late Vergie Mae Oxendine Sutton.

Ronnie attended both Magnolia and Pembroke High Schools prior to entering the United States Air Force in 1958. Following four years in the Air Force, he returned to Robeson County where he attended Pembroke State College and later graduated from the University of West Florida in Pensacola, Florida.

In 1964 Ronnie entered the United States Navy's Officer Flight Training Program and earned his Naval Wings of Gold in February 1966. During his Naval career, he served several tours flying the P-3C Orion, a four engine turboprop anti-submarine aircraft. In addition, he served as a flight instructor in the Navy's Flight Training Program at Pensacola, Florida.

While in the Navy, Ronnie flew in excess of 3800 flight hours, including more than 600 hours of combat in Vietnam where he earned two Air Medals. After returning stateside, he was the Flight Deck Officer on the Aircraft Carrier USS John F. Kennedy, (CV-67). In 1974, Ronnie became a Recruiting Officer supervising 85 recruiters at more than 25 locations throughout Virginia and part of

Ronnie retired in 1982 with the rank of Navy Commander (0-5) following his command tour as the Commanding Officer of the Navy Reserve Officer Training Unit (NROTC) serving Louisiana State University and Southern University in Baton Rouge, Louisiana.

Earning his BA Degree at the University of West Florida, Pensacola, Florida in 1970. Ronnie later graduated from the Naval War College, Newport, RI where he earned a MS Degree in 1977. He then received a MA Degree in personnel management from Central Michigan University, Mt. Pleasant, Michigan in 1979. After retiring from the Navy, Ronnie received his law degree from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill in May 1985.

Ronnie was a partner in the Arnold Locklear Law firm in Pembroke from 1985 until 1996. He then entered into a solo practice in 1996 on Union Chapel Road where he continues to practice today.

Elected to the North Carolina House of Representatives in 1992, Ronnie served continuously in the General Assembly for eighteen (18) years. While there he chaired several key committees including an important Judiciary Committee and The American Indian and Veterans Affairs Committee.

Born into a large family, four boys and four girls, all four Sutton boys served in the military. The oldest Gerald, also a Vietnam Veteran retired from the United States Air Force in 1974 and lived in Boise, Idaho with his wife Linda and their two children until his death in 2011. Edward before his death in 2013 served in the US Army. Ernie, the youngest served in the US Army and later retired from the US Navy. In all, three of the four Sutton brothers retired from the United States military.

Ronnie is married to the former Genny Chavis, daughter of the late John French and Narva Cummings Chavis of the Philadelphus Community. They have two daughters Ronette Alesia Sutton Gerber and Fonda Lynn Sutton. His wife Genny, and both daughters, like Ronnie, attended UNCP Pembroke. Genny a retired registered nurse, was a member of the first UNCP BSN graduate Class of 1994. Ronette received her undergraduate degree from UNCP and both a masters and her law degree from UNC Chapel Hill. An attorney like her dad, she is presently the Associate General Counsel at UNC Pembroke. Fonda studied biology while at UNCP.

Ronnie and Genny are the proud grandparents of four grandchildren, Neal Arthur French Sutton (18), Greyson Gerber (13), Garrett Gerber (12) and Lauren Alesia Gerber (10) all of Robeson County.

Ronnie is looking forward to retiring from the practice of law and spending more time with his family.

Lumbee Pinecone Patchwork Regalia

Each year the newly crowned Ambassadors slips on a calico or cotton dress, dons a traditional apron, and envelops herself in a rich tradition that can only be described as Lumbee.

Over the years the Miss/Teen/Junior/Little Miss Lumbees' have worn Lumbee Pinecone Patchwork dresses as an outward sign of their dedication to cultural awareness, cultural integrity, and cultural renewal.

The Lumbee dress takes its name from the symbolic pinecone patchwork worn on the apron. The pinecone symbol is based on the longleaf pinecone; when turned on its end the pinecone matches the intricate design of the patchwork.





This reign was a true blessing and an honor. For one last time, just for you Mom, I am your Teen Miss Lumbee, Genna Locklear.


