

Reverend Mike and Mrs. Quae Cummings have been serving together in Lumbee and other tribal communities through Burnt Swamp Baptist Association ministries for more than 40 years. Mrs. Quae is an enrolled member of the Coharie Tribe in Sampson County where she was born and Reverend Mike is Lumbee from Pembroke. They share a strong Christian faith and family upbringing. Both grew up in large families where share-crop farming provided livelihood and life lessons learned from hard work. Family, faith, and farming are common threads woven into the experience of most couples of their generation.

While they enjoy life as grandparents, their three adult children are occupied in their respective careers. Jody and his wife Tina live in Odenton, MD. He is Senior Counsel to the Solicitor for the Department of the Interior in Washington, DC. Jason and his wife Synora are parents of Ava, Elli and Elim and live in Smithfield, NC. He is a Process Development Engineer with Grifols Therapeutics in Clayton, NC. Jessica is an Income Maintenance Case Worker with the Robeson County Department of Social Services and lives with her parents. All three treasure their Lumbee and Coharie ancestry and tradition.

Reverend Mike began pastoral ministry as a 20 year

old at New Bethel Baptist Church in Sampson County in 1970. He and Mrs. Quae married in 1972. They lived in the church parsonage in that beautiful Coharie community until October, 1978. He returned to Pembroke with Mrs. Quae and their 2 sons to pastor Mt. Airy Baptist Church. Mrs. Quae began employment with Burnt Swamp Baptist Association in 1979, soon after they moved into Mt. Airy community. Reverend Mike served Mt. Airy Church for 10 years before becoming Director of Missions for Burnt Swamp Association in 1988.

The Burnt Swamp Association is an organization of 70 Baptist churches in Lumbee, Tuscarora, Coharie, Waccamaw Siouan, and Haliwa-Saponi tribal communities. The Association organized in 1881 and is the first organization of Indian churches put forth by Indian church leaders for the development of churches in Indian communities. Together, Reverend Mike and Mrs. Quae have assisted these congregations with their respective gospel focused ministries. Facilitating cooperation and fellowship among their churches, leading strategies to involve churches in gospel ministry outreach and supporting church leaders in their key roles comprise daily challenges for Reverend Mike and Mrs. Quae. Navigating through geographical distance and individual uniqueness of each congregation in the Association has helped them to value and respect each one.

Through the Association office, they have served alongside other Lumbee community leaders to improve the quality of life for Lumbee people. The Interdenominational Fellowship of Lumbee churches brought several years of cooperation among churches. The Native American Interfaith Ministry grew from that interfaith experience to serve people burdened by substance abuse, homelessness, and health disparities. The Robeson Family Counseling Center came into being to provide support for individuals struggling with personal and family dilemmas. Forming partnerships with other church denominations, local government entities, health care providers, UNC-P, UNC-CH, the Lumbee Tribe, LRDA and the NC Commission of Indian Affairs has placed Reverend Mike and Mrs. Quae in strategic places to mobilize the faith community to serve people.

The Burnt Swamp Association has good standing as an influential community organization. Reverend Mike and Mrs. Quae join a long list of notable community leaders connected with the Association. Their work in the Association brought them state-wide recognition among North Carolina Baptists when Reverend Mike was elected President of the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina in 1999. He became the Convention's first non-Anglo President, having also served a longer tenure than any previous President. Together, this couple has enjoyed love and support in Indian communities throughout this state.

LED, Inc. is under contract with the Department of Defense (DOD) and Department of Labor (DOL) for 8a projects that consist of approximately 1.2 million dollars.


