

### On the Job Training

This program provides training in the private or pubic sector. It is given to a participant who has been hired first by the employer, and occurs while the participant is engaged in productive work that is providing knowledge or skills essential to the full and adequate performance of the job. The employer is reimbursed 50% of the participant's wages.

### **Work Experience**

This program is a short-term or part-time work assignment in the public sector. It is designed to enhance the employability of individuals through the development of good work habits and basic work skills.

### **Classroom Training**

This program activity is any training of the type normally conducted in an institutional setting. It includes vocational education and is designed to provide individuals with the technical skills and information required to perform a specific job or group of jobs.
