Bobby Dean Locklear

Bobby Dean Locklear has been a noteworthy leader in the affairs of the Lumbee people. He has served on the Board of Directors for Lumbee Regional Development Association for 34 years and has been committed to providing services that assist disadvantaged Indian people in Robeson, Hoke, and Scotland Counties. Mr. Locklear has also been instrumental in Robeson County government. He served as a member for 16 years on the Robeson County Board of Commissioners, as well as Commissioner Chairman for four years. He has served on the Robeson County Board of Health, Robeson County Board of Social Services, the Lumber River Council of Governments, and a member of the Pembroke Jaycees.

In addition to his active roles in the community, Mr. Locklear has been a proud advocate for local public education. He earned his bachelor's from Pembroke State University, now the University of North Carolina at Pembroke and a Masters in Guidance and Counseling from Western Carolina University.

Mr. Locklear spent most of his thirty-four-year tenure in the Robeson County school system as a guidance counselor, where he advised on state advisory councils for education, Indian education, and vocational education. He was awarded the Order of the Long Leaf Pine in 2016 for his exemplary service and commitment to the state.

At the ripe age of 85, he still lives with his wife Theresa Revels Locklear of 59 years. He has four children, eight grandchildren, and nine great grandchildren. He is a member of Pembroke First Baptist Church. His favorite hobbies include attending auctions and gathering together with his family to eat a good meal that he calls "a party."

Scotland Memorial Health System in Laurinburg and UNC Health Southeastern in Lumberton are teaming up to promote better health for the residents of Pembroke and the surrounding communities.

The two health systems co-sponsored the Lumbee Tribe's Dance of the Spring Moon PowWow in May and will be co-sponsors for the LRDA Lumbee Homecoming in July.

"We recognize that we are both here for the public good and, in many instances, competition isn't necessary," said UNC Health Southeastern President/ CEO Chris Ellington.


By partnering, we have been able to bring Dr. Woriax in together, something neither of us could do alone. We look forward to working with Southeastern more in the future."



Training and consultation is offered to child care providers on applying promotion, prevention, and intervention when working with children who experience developmental and/or behavioral health symptoms. FREE High Quality PRE-K

Your child may be eligible to attend Robeson County's NC Pre-K Program. The NC Pre-K Program is designed to provide high-quality educational experiences to enhance school readiness for eligible four year old children.

Children must be four years old by August 31, 2022 to be eligible for the program. Parents must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate, current immunization records, income verification, and proof of chronic health conditions, if applicable. All items are required to determine eligibility.

Where Are They Now?

Miss Lumbee 2005 - Erica Dellinger Atkinson

Seventeen years ago, on the night when Erica Dellinger was crowned Miss Lumbee, a historic event had taken place.

Largely because it was not Erica's first (or even second, or third) rodeo as a Lumbee Ambassador. Quite the opposite, since she had just become the very first to achieve all four titles-Little Miss Lumbee in 1991, Junior Miss Lumbee in 1999, Teen Miss Lumbee in 2001, and finally, Miss Lumbee in 2005.

A few days ago, I had the honor to sit down and have a lovely conversation with Erica. In it, we talked about her four years as a Lumbee Ambassador - what the "honor and humbling experience" meant to her then, and what it means to her now.

Erica's journey with Lumbee Ambassadorship began when she was six years old. A Robeson County native, she hails from a family of UNCP alumni. Her mother, Rhonda Godwin Dellinger, who grew up in the Moss Neck Community of Pembroke, studied education there and went on to teach at Pembroke Elementary for 35 years. Her father, Tony Dellinger, originally from Garner, North Carolina, studied business and played basketball at UNCP. Erica's younger sister, Elicia Dellinger, received a biology degree from UNCP in 2012, and now works in Raleigh, North Carolina.

Though she doesn't remember the experience herself, her mother recalls the funny memory in which she brought Erica in for the preliminary screening for Little Miss Lumbee. It was 1990, and Erica's first-ever pageant.

Upon facing that panel of unfamiliar faces, as Erica told me, she stopped in her tracks at the door, too nervous. She looked up resolutely at her mother, and said,

So she didn't do Little Miss Lumbee that year, but between that summer and the next, Erica gathered up a little courage, and she came back for the next year's pageant. And she won it.

In the next fifteen years that followed, Erica made winning a habit, until she had all four titles claimed. When I asked her if winning all four was a personal goal of hers at the time, she laughed and shook her head. "No, it was more of something that just happened." In that decision, she said that she simply had fun as Little Miss Lumbee, and wanted to do it again. Later on, she also said that her admiration for Becky Goins (who was Erica's Miss Lumbee back in 1991) encouraged her to keep coming back to compete. "I had Becky as my role model and mentor. I thought, this is Miss Lumbee. It was something I wanted to work towards and achieve."

In that way, Erica said that she saw the Junior and Teen titles as great experiences that could act as stepping stones towards Miss Lumbee. She says that 2000, shortly after her time as Junior Miss Lumbee. year-old daughter, Elin Harper, and a nine-month-old son Kaden Reed, who both have birthdays coming up soon, in August.

As Lumbee Homecoming approaches again, I asked Erica what it's like to be recognized by people as the first to hold all four Lumbee titles. She humbly approached the question, saying, "It was really an honor to be able to represent the Lumbee people that many times, and to have that achievement. I think it's really great now to watch other girls work towards and achieve that goal too." And, speaking about Lumbee Ambassadorship nowadays, Erica said that, as a former Miss Lumbee, she enjoys being able to watch the pageants continue to grow. "It's a great avenue for these young women to put themselves out there, to vocalize issues that they're passionate about, and to showcase their talents, whether it be singing or dancing or something completely different."

Erica said that she understands competing for the Lumbee titles can be a very daunting experience. Still, she encourages young Lumbee women to take the chance, because the chance at Ambassadorship is well worth it: "Sometimes people get too focused on the pageant itself, and forget what the experience really means or what it really looks like. There's so much you can get from it—the scholarship, the friendships you make, the sisterhood, developing all these life skills that will take you so far in life."

While speaking to Erica, it was made clear that she thought her Ambassadorship was a beautiful and humbling opportunity. It taught her infinite lessons about her culture, and about herself, too.

As our conversation came to a close, I asked her if she had any parting words of wisdom for present and future ambassadors. "I know a lot of people would probably say this," she laughed, "but soak in each and every moment. It's your experience to make the most out of it. You learn so much about the Lumbee people, and you grow so much as a person. You'll learn things that will transition with you into your career, whatever that may be, and really, skills and memories that vou'll cherish for life."
