


Grand Marshall Charles William Moore

Grand Marshall Zeb B. Oxendine







On the Job Training

This program is a short-term or part-time work assignment in the public and private sector. It is designed to enhance the employability of individuals through the development of good work habits and basic work skills.

Classroom Training

This program activity is any training of the type normally conducted in an institutional setting. It includes vocational education and is designed to provide individuals with the technical skills and information required to perform a specific job or group of jobs.
