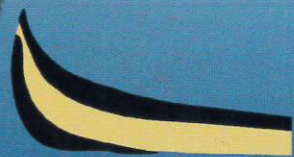

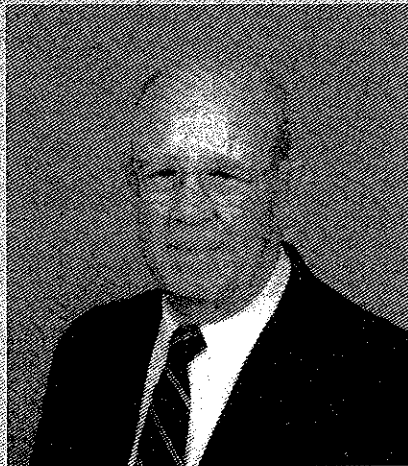

Grand Marshall Zeb B. Oxendine



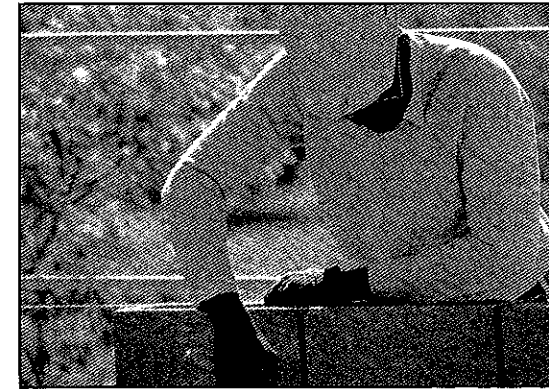

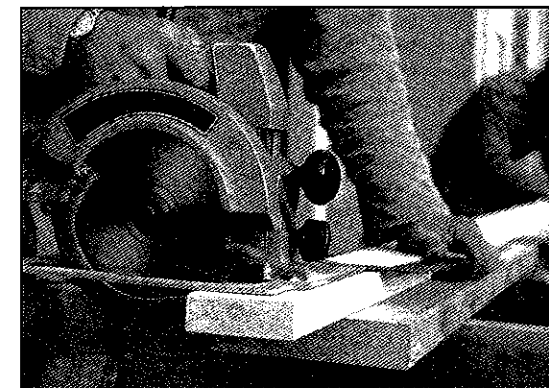
Work Experience
