










James Manne Shows Grand Marshall



Mr. John "Ned" Sampson is a retired coach and educator, who was a very outstanding athlete and coach. He is a 1952 graduate of the University of North Carolina at Pembroke. He served as a basketball coach and teacher at Magnolia High School from 1953 to 1967, and at Pembroke High School from 1968 to 1977.

Mr. Sampson received many honors in his coaching and basketball career. In 2005, he was inducted into the Hall of Fame of the North Carolina High School Athletic Association. He was inducted into the Athletic Hall of Fame of UNC-Pembroke in 1980. He received honors from the North Carolina Coaches Association for serving over 20 years. He had a winning record and coached championship teams in men's and women's basketball in the Indian High School Athletic Conference.

In high school, "Ned" Sampson excelled in three sports. His greatest achievement however, was in basketball. Playing at a height of 6 foot, 2 inches and 190 pounds, Sampson was known as a pure shooter who could use either hand. Sampson was featured in the book *Playing Before an Overflow Crowd* by Bruce Barton and Tim Brayboy that chronicled the all-Indian basketball league, wherein Sampson played and coached.

Mr. Sampson had an outstanding career at UNC-Pembroke. Although his talent was mostly unnoticed nationally, he averaged 24.3 points per game in his senior year at UNC-P in 1952. He scored a school record of 40 points against Campbell University. Mr. Sampson played in a game against a traveling All-Star team. After the game, Sampson received a letter from Dick Groat, an All-American basketball star at Duke University, saying he was the best basketball player he had ever played against.

Coach Sampson has served as a leader in several civic and community organizations. He served as volunteer coach for Little League Baseball for Indian youths in Robeson county from 1953 to 1963. He is charter member and long term leader in the Pembroke Lions Club, and a member of Berea Baptist Church in Pembroke.

Mr. Sampson family has an outstanding record in basketball. Mr. Sampson's son Kelvin, played basketball and baseball at Pembroke High School and at UNC-Pembroke. Kelvin Sampson served as head coach of men's basketball at Oklahoma University for 12 years. He is now an assistant coach for the Milwaukee Bucks NBA Professional Basketball Team. Ned and Kelvin are the only father-son tandem in the Athletic Hall of Fame at UNC-Pembroke.



As her children grew older, Mrs. Ransom worked with the Lumbee Regional Development Association's Center for the Arts. This position allowed her to become involved with the Miss Lumbee Pageant. For many years she served as the chaperone and business manager for Miss Lumbee. She has also served as the chaperone for several recipients of the Miss North Carolina title. Her involvement with Miss North Carolina preliminary pageants allowed her to promote Miss Lumbee and also attend the Miss America pageants. She has also served as a committee member of the Miss UNC-Pembroke pageants.

Later in life she became the district manager of the Victim and Justice Services office. She supervised 6 county offices and would also recruit summer interns to work in the offices.

In 2002 Mrs. Ransom retired. However, she still remains very active in the community and is frequently asked to judge pageants and provide guidance and encouragement to young ladies.

On behalf of the Ransom family, we feel honored to have our mother serve as a Grand Marshall of the Lumbee Homecoming parade.

LED manages 57 Lease Purchase Homes in Robeson and Hoke Counties.

These are scattered site homes which will be transferred to the housing client once they meet the conditions of their Memorandum of Agreements (MDA) and housing policy terms.

All 57 homes are stick built or modular on permanent foundations.

All homes were built with federal funds between 2000 and 2002 under the HUD program, called the Native American Housing and Self-Determination Act.

Management of Properties

LED provides management and supervision services for LRDA, Inc. facility services maintenance personnel, providing upkeep to nearly \$15 million worth of Property Assets.

LED selects general contractors or subcontractors for all properties in the Lease Purchase Housing Program. Providing the same for any/all community service centers owned by LRDA in five locations throughout the County of Robeson which includes all Head Start, Early Start, Tudors Court Day Care Center and the LRDA Central Administrative Service Center, in Pembroke, NC

Beginning June 1, 2009 management of these properties was contracted to Lumbee Enterprise Development, Inc. a subsidiary of Lumbee Revitalization and Community Development Corporation.
