

Mr. Maynor was an educator for over 25 years in the Robeson County School System. He served as Executive Director of Lumbee Regional Development Association, Inc. (LRDA) for 14 years. 

REVEREND CLAUDIE DIAL "The Lumbee Evangelist", 87 years old, is a veteran of World War II. He and his first wife, Essie Mae Dial (1924 - 2004) parented 12 children, 9 of who are still living. Rev. Dial has since remarried and he and his wife, Ernestine Dial, also a pastor, share a passion for evangelism.

Rev. Dial spent his life ministering both at home and abroad. Rev. Dial was one of the first pastors to set up tent revivals in Robeson County. In 1953 during one revival Rev. Dial set up a tent with 3,000 seats and drew a crowd of over 6,000 people. During his time in the Army he ministered in 7 different European countries and also spread the gospel in the Fiji Islands during his term in the Peace Corps. In addition, he has written two hymnals and is currently working on his third.

Rev. Dial chartered the not for profit organization "Friends of the Son." His organization helps educate students through high school and on collegiate levels. Rev. Dial's expertise as a builder has been instrumental in the construction of the 21 churches he has built in 4 different countries including the United States, Belize, Guatemala, and Mexico. In addition he has built a mission station in Belize and a children's home in Guatemala. His churches are often started with little to no funds and are dependent upon the support and participation of the community in which they are built. Rev. Dial wants to see Christian ministries flourish as far as land goes south through Central and South America.

Motor Vehicle Accidents Kill More Lumbees

There is a crisis of death by motor vehicle accidents among American Indians in Robeson County. Between the periods of 1999-2004, some 121 American Indians died in motor vehicle accidents. The death rate for motor vehicle accidents among American Indians in Robeson is about 3 times higher than the rate for Whites in North Carolina.

Did you know?

The death rate from motor vehicle accidents among American Indians was 52.5 per 100,000 compared to the rate for Whites in North Carolina of 18.1 per 100,000.

I always knew that I was Indian and I was proud of my culture and heritage but my pride reached an all time high this year. I have always been asked how it felt to be Indian and what it meant to be "Lumbee" but until this year, I never had an answer. You can't be taught to be an Indian, it comes from within!.

What <u>can</u> be learned and what I have been taught this year are the traditions and values that uphold our culture. I've had countless experiences this year. Among the first was my trip to Washington D.C. where I attended the hearing for the Lumbee Bill and met Senator Dole and Congressman Mike McIntyre. I've also visited numerous schools where I educated

students on the Lumbee tribe and some of our traditions. I would count these as my most rewarding experiences as Mr. Lumbee. You have no idea how many times I hear, "...ooh, ooh, ooh, there's a real Indian!" And was asked if I lived in a teepee.

I was also honored with the privilege of attending a broadcasting on cultural diversity at the University of North Carolina at Pembroke. Most of my reign was spent at powwows and cultural gatherings which I enjoyed the most. No offense to anyone who invited me to entertain but I always enjoyed powwowing as opposed to entertaining. It was during my reign that I learned more about dancing, the drum, the circle, the meaning of songs, and respect for all Nations of people (Native or non-Native).

The most breathtaking experience was my trip to Albuquerque, New Mexico where I had the pleasure to dance with over 3500 dancers including some of the best in the Nation. I experienced such a powerful and spiritual moment in the arena when the Eagle lifted his wings. It took me back to the Bible verse Isaiah 40:31 "But they that wait upon the Lord, shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; they shall walk, and not faint."

I give honor and glory to my creator, Lord, and Savior Jesus Christ for his promises and his blessings and for keeping me throughout my life and my reign this year. To the future ambassadors, I hope you get the opportunities to make memories as I have.
